UNIVERSAL WASTE ONLY

- 1. Used Oil for recycle.** - Residential generated motor oil, hydraulic oil and transmission fluid, no limit.
- 2. Waste Oil for recycle.** - Residential generated oil, contaminated with water or anti-freeze, **5 gallon limit.**
- 3. Residential, NON-COMMERCIAL Florescent lamps for recycle.**
- 4. Residential, NON-COMMERCIAL Automotive batteries for recycle, THIS IS A FEE ITEM.**
- 5. Residential, NON-COMMERCIAL Anti-freeze for recycle, 4 gallon limit.**
- 6. Rechargeable batteries for recycle, see Attendant.**

RECYCLE BY THE NUMBER

#1 GLASS – ANYTHING THAT SHATTERS

GREEN, CLEAR, BROWN, FROSTED, BLUE, CERAMIC, MIRRORS, PLATES, CUPS, GLASSES AND WINDOW GLASS REMOVED FROM THE FRAMES. (NO WINDSHIELDS, PLEASE)

#2 ALUMINUM BEVERAGE CANS

#3 TIN CANS

PET FOOD, DRY PAINT, FOIL ITEMS AND EMPTY AEROSOL CANS.

#4 CARD BOARD

ANY CLEAN, DRY, BROKEN DOWN CARDBOARD
ALL PRINTED, COLORED AND SHINY CARDBOARD ACCEPTED.

#5 NEWSPAPER - INCLUDES INSERTS

#6 MIXED PAPER - IF IT RIPS OR TEARS, ITS PAPER

ALL CLEAN PAPER, JUNK MAIL, MAGAZINES, PHONE BOOKS, CEREAL BOXES, EGG CARTONS, AND FOOD BOXES.
(NO CHRISTMAS WRAP PAPER OR FOIL LINED ITEMS)

#7 HDEP #2 - OPAQUE OR SOLID PLASTIC BOTTLES

PLEASE REMOVE CAPS FROM BOTTLES.

#8 PETE #1 - CLEAR OR SEE-THRU PLASTIC BOTTLES

PLEASE REMOVE CAPS FROM BOTTLES.

#9 USED MOTOR OIL

RESIDENTIAL USED OIL MUST BE WATER AND ANTI-FREEZE FREE.
SEE ATENDANT FOR PROPER DISPOSAL OF RESIDENTIALLY GENERATED CONTAMINATED OIL AND USED ANTI-FREEZE

#10 FLUORESCENT BULBS

SALES OF THESE MATERIALS OFFSETS THE COST
OF RUNNING THE FACILITY
ALL REVENUES ARE RETURNED TO THE GENERAL FUND
TO OFFSET YOUR TAXES

SIGNAGE DIRECTORY

GREEN SIGNS = MANDATORY RECYCLING

YELLOW SIGNS = FEE ITEMS

RED SIGNS = REGULATION

WHITE SIGNS = GENERAL INFORMATION

1. – Residential fee based items may be paid for by check OR cash. (Receipts will be given for ALL transactions)
2. – All user fees cover the cost of disposal ONLY and do not generate any profit. Any revenues are returned to the general fund of the Town of New Boston.
3. – New Boston's Solid Waste is transported to an incinerator for disposal. Please, **DO NOT** place any item into your trash that will not burn. (Metal, dirt, rocks, glass, etc.)
4. – Chemicals, Paints of ANY KIND, pesticides or ANY Hazardous Material CANNOT be left at the Transfer Station. Annual Residential Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day will be the last Saturday of June.

5. – Non-Compliance – New Boston has a **mandatory** Town recycling policy, approved by Town vote in 1993. Your trash may be inspected to ensure compliance. Your access to the facility to deposit your trash and recyclables could be revoked if you do not adhere to this mandatory recycling policy.

NEW BOSTON GENERATED MATERIALS ONLY

Unacceptable items: Asbestos material or any item that is or contains hazardous material.

Passenger Vehicle Tires

Tires up to 18" - \$2.00, tires **MUST** be off the rims.

Large Truck Tires

Tires 16" to 24" - \$15.00, tires **MUST** be off the rims.

Unacceptable items: Loader tires and any rims.

Freon Items

Refrigerators, Freezers and Air Conditioners - \$10.00

Propane Tanks

Tanks up to 20 lbs - \$1.00.

Tanks 20 lbs to 30 lbs - \$20.00.

Televisions/Monitors

Computer Monitors - \$5.00, Televisions - \$10.00.

Batteries (Vehicle) - \$1.00
